Services for Disabled Children and Young People

The formal consultation has now closed.

The proposals for the new Specialist Disabled Children and Young People's Service were approved by Cabinet on 30 November 2016.

Mark Parkinson, Director of Education would like to thank all parents and carers who took part. He very much appreciated the time parents who are on the parent carer forum gave to designing the way forward. The group were instrumental in co-producing the changes to culture, process and provision that the Council would like to deliver.

The new model will provide a joined up approach, under one senior manager. The manager will lead on the disabled children and young people's social work function, new family support roles, responsibility to ensure community short breaks are provided, the Transitions Team and Pinewood (residential respite unit).

The new model will provide a more consistent, transparent and personalised service that is better able to meet the needs of disabled children and young people 0-25 by providing early help. The model will ensure that we deliver a more joined up approach to support service users throughout key developmental milestones and the point of transition into adulthood.

The partnership work with parents and carers has been invaluable so this will continue in January. The Co-production group will be looking at supporting the development of detailed service criteria and a local approach to alternative assessment and support plans that sit at the level below statutory social care.

How do I find rate and review on the local offer?

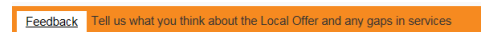
