OPPORTUNITIES TO SPEAK TO PARENTS

OPPORTUNITIES WE ARE LOOKING FOR

As a school, we are always looking for opportunities with employers in the following areas:

- 1) Employers happy to take pupils for work experience we aim to do this with our year 13 pupils for half a day a week for a 6-week period.
- 2) Employers willing to have pupils come and have an hour walk around an employment setting, to allow them to have experience of a workplace and to know if it is an area of employment that they are interested in, before embarking on work experience
- 3) Employers who could come in to school (Physically or remotely) and set pupils/class a work based challenge or task, that they could then have feedback on
- 4) Employers who could offer mock interviews to pupils
- 5) Employers who can come and talk to pupils about opportunities within their area, ideally that are at a level that our pupils can attain, how to get into it, qualifications and skills needed.
