• Almost all respondents agreed/ strongly agreed with the statements except for:

Regarding homework: 1 respondent replied they didn't know if the amount of homework was the right level for their child, one respondent said they would like more homework for their child (secondary).

Regarding bullying: 14% of respondents said that they did not know how the school dealt with bullying as their child had not experienced bullying.

One respondent said that they disagreed with the statement that the school responded well to any concerns but this reply was anonymous and therefore we are unable to take further.
